**Nominations**, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the organisation, may be made at any time from **Friday, 8 September 2017**. They must reach my office or postal address or AEC email inbox **not later 12:00noon (AWST) on Friday, 22 September 2017**.

A Nomination Form is enclosed. Additional forms are available from me or the office of the organisation.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00noon (AWST) on Friday, 22 September 2017. Withdrawal of nominations must be in writing and addressed to Simon Bulloch, Returning Officer, Australian Electoral Commission.

**The ballot**, if required, will open and close on Monday, 9 October 2017 at the Divisional Conference to be held at Pan Pacific Perth, 207 Adelaide Terrace Perth WA 6000 commencing at 9:00am (AWST). If any applications for absentee votes are received by the Returning Officer prior to the meeting, the result of the ballot will be declared after postal votes have been included. The postal ballot will open on Tuesday, 10 October 2017 and close at 10:00am (AWST) on Tuesday, 24 October 2017.

**Absent voting:** If you are unable to attend the meeting and wish to vote in the ballot, you may request an application for absentee vote or appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf. These requests must reach me not later than 12noon (AWST) on Friday, 6 October 2017.
